- **Play a Role**



John 17:3

Even though I was once a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent man,


I was shown mercy because

and have seen him."**




John 14:8-9

How can you say, 'Show us the Father'?




John 6:45

the gospel of our Lord Jesus.**




1 John 2:3-6


